BANGOR

- Worked continually with Government Departments, Council and Traders towards completion of the Public Realm Scheme, which will regenerate the Town Centre.
- Constantly engaging with the PSNI for adequate policing in the Town Centre, Residential & Commercial areas to tackle crime and Anti-Social Behaviour.
- Car Parking in the Town Centre is an issue of concern and we continue to lobby DRD and Translink for increased provision.
- A strong advocate for progress on the long overdue Queen's Parade Redevelopment Scheme.
- Working with Council and Agencies on exciting new Hotel Development on the Castle Leisure Centre site.
- Participated in the development and promotion of Aurora Aquatic and Leisure Complex and the regeneration of Clandeboye Retail Park.



HOUSING

- Supported and been successful in seeing many people rehoused through the Housing Executive and Housing Associations.
- Assisted Housing Associations to identify suitable sites and process Planning Applications, for much needed new homes, i.e. Bloomfield, Dunville, Kilcooley and Rathgill.
- Successfully assisted residents to avail of the Warm Home and Boiler Replacement Schemes, and inclusion in the Double Glazing and Kitchen Refurbishment Programmes.
- Working with Community Associations and Agencies for continual improvements in local areas.



ECONOMY

- Continue to engage with Invest NI to promote North Down and support local businesses.
- Assisted with business development and Planning Applications within Towns and Industrial sites.
- Lobbied on Rates re-valuation and participated with traders in Rate Review meetings.
- As an active member of the Enterprise Committee I have highlighted the challenge of Energy Costs with Minister Bell and Utility Regulator.
- Promoted North Down as a Tourist destination with our Golf Courses, Museums, Parks, Beaches, Pickie Park and leisure facilities.
- Campaigned for introduction of Corporation Tax to 12.5% by 2018 to make North Down and NI more attractive for investment.



VILLAGE RENEWAL

- Delivering investment in Crawfordsburn, Helen's Bay, Conlig and Groomsport through the development of Village Plans.
- Involved with Ards and North Down Rural Partnership and Council to ensure funding opportunities for Villages and the ongoing development of the Coastal Path at Seahill and Cultra.
- Worked to ensure Planning Applications within Villages maintain their Character.
- Assisted Residents Associations with Environmental Improvements.



EDUCATION

- Supported Schools across North Down in their expansion and development plans and lobbied Minister for sufficient funding in the Classroom.
- Helping to tackle Educational Underachievement through skills and apprenticeship programmes for our young people at SERC College.
- Continue to press for investment in local school buildings and facilities including Holywood Primary, Nursery, Priory College, Sullivan Upper along with Bangor Central Primary and St Columbanus.
- Governor of both Rathmore Primary School and Holywood Primary School.
- Worked for 'Safe Routes to School' outside our Schools with Transport NI and PSNI.



ROADS

- Upgrading of Road Safety measures along A2 Dual Carriageway.
- Resurfacing and maintenance of our Roads Network and Footpaths remain a priority.
- Continue to press for Street Lighting repairs across North Down and welcome DUP Minister McIlveen's £1million investment to tackle the backlog.
- Ensuring Weed Control and Grass Cutting on roads, carriageways and residential areas is improved.
- Campaigning for a Pelican Crossing at Sullivan Upper School.
- Highlighted need for appropriate Winter Gritting arrangements to keep our roads safe.
 The introduction of 'Resident Parking
- The introduction of 'Resident Parking Schemes' remains a priority.
- Protecting the Free Travel Pass scheme for our older people.



SPEAKING UP FOR YOU...

HOLYWOOD

- Fully involved in seeing the Town Centre regenerated and more attractive for residents and visitors through the completion of the Holywood Public Realm Scheme.
- Worked consistently to further the proposed Front Development at Shore Road.
- Redevelopment of Kerr Park and Spafield is a priority and the provision of new Sports Pitches.
- Kinnegar Sewage Works nearing completion which will eradicate the environmental pollution.
- Supported local events such as Holywood Culture Night and May Day.



DONAGHADEE

- Public Realm Scheme is well underway which is giving the coastal town a real boost.
- Ongoing discussions with Traders on new projects for the regeneration of the Town Centre.
- Working alongside Council and Tourism NI to promote events within the Town and encourage visitors.
- The extension of the Gas Network remains a priority.



HEALTH

- Continue to lobby for investment towards a new Health and Wellbeing Centre in Bangor.
- Worked for the completion of the new Acute Services Unit and General Ward Block at the Ulster Hospital through a £243million investment.
- Pressed for provision of Cath Lab at the Ulster Hospital.
- Engaging with GPs, Pharmacists, Dentists and Nurses to ensure fair pay.
- Supported many Health related Charities through Fundraising and Health Promotion.



CULTURE, ARTS & LEISURE

As Vice-Chair of the DCAL Committee I have lobbied extensively for:

- Adequate funding for retention of Library Services across North Down.
- Equity of Funding for local Arts and Sports Clubs and throughout Northern Ireland and the protection of the Ulster Orchestra.
- Funding of local Football Clubs through Stadia Funding Programme.
- Adequate resources for Ulster Folk & Transport Museum at Cultra.
- The completion of the Kingspan Stadium at Ravenhill and the redevelopment of the National Stadium at Windsor Park.



ENVIRONMENT

- Worked for the protection of Cairn Wood Forest and Ballysallagh Reservoir with DRD Minister McIlveen in finding a solution to ensure they are kept open for public access.
- Promoted the 'Think SAFE' campaign encouraging Farm Safety.
- Lobbied DARD alongside Diane Dodds MEP and supported our farmers to ensure they get a fair price for produce.
- Promoting our Agri-Food Sector to ensure that local producers benefit from the NI Year of Food and Drink 2016.
- Worked in conjunction with PSNI and agencies to tackle rural crime.
- Opposed development of 60 acre Solar Farm intrusion into Countryside at Clandeboye, Bangor.



MILLISLE

- Worked with local community to develop a beneficial Village Plan in order to attract investment and regeneration.
- Supporting the Millisle Youth Forum to encourage and develop the work with local young people in 'The Garage.'
- Regeneration of the Copeland's Windmill has been a priority.
- I welcome the upgrading of Millisle Sewage Facility to end environmental pollution and have taken part in a number of beach cleans.
- Lobbied Transport NI to ensure Roads and Footpaths are improved and maintained and engage regularly with the Housing Executive to develop Housing within the Village.
